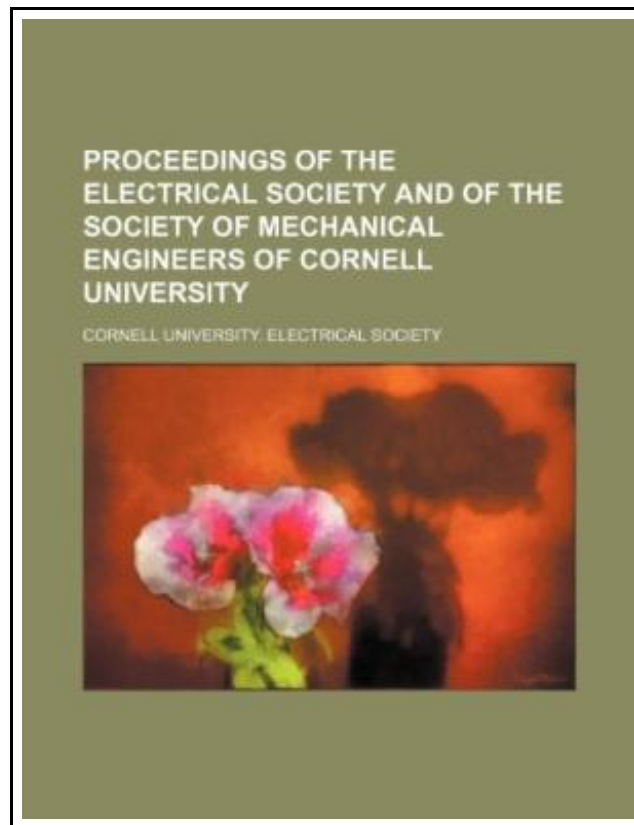

By a high speed, I mean a speed considerably higher than has yet been attained, and will mention 150 miles per hour as a speed which seems desirable and practicable to attain. When we remember that the first practical electric railway was that constructed at Berlin in 1879, and that the subject of high speed electric traction has only received attention within the past two years, with not a single practical demonstration, we must be content to scan a rather limited literature, and draw our conclusions from this and from developments of allied subjects. Let us first take up the subject of Track and Roadbed. Although the track is of prime importance, it appears, from a letter published in the Railroad Gazette, that other things as well as the rails must be much improved before very high speeds will be safe. This letter points out the fact that in August, -1 892, the accidents on steam roads were attributable to track, 5 ; to equipment, 15 ; and to negligence in operation, 31 . If this be a fair average, we see that not only the track, but other conditions must be improved in a marked degree. In selecting rails the two chief considerations are weight and hardness.
